Gundog Working Tests

The following classes of competition are recognized by the Kennel Club:

- OPEN. Open to all dogs of a specified breed or breeds, although preference may be given to dogs which have gained a place or certificate of merit at a Field Trial, been placed First, Second or Third in an Open GWT, or won a Novice GWT.
- NOVICE. Confined to dogs which have not gained a place or certificate of merit at a Field Trial, been placed First, Second or Third in an Open GWT or First in a Novice GWT held in accordance with Kennel Club Rules and Field Trial Regulations.
- PUPPY. Confined to dogs of specific breed or breeds less than eighteen months of age on the date of the test.

Perpetual Trophies - If anyone still has any trophies would you kindly return them please.

All cheques to be made payable to the G.R.C.N. and no entries will be accepted without the required entry fee.

We cannot emphasise enough the need for volunteers on the day to help ensure our events go ahead. If you would like to help the Club with dummy throwing/placing; please contact the Working Test Secretary; preferably before test day. Without helpers the tests may be cancelled.

Much of the terrain at our events is uneven and can make walking difficult, especially in adverse weather. Please make sure you are fit enough to adequately cope with the grounds.

As per Kennel Club Ltd J regs: No person shall carry out punitive correction or harsh handling at a working test or any GRCN events. No person attending a working test may allow a bitch in season to be on the ground.
